## MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION

## 1. Up-to-date immunization record signed by M.D. must include:

**DTaP**–<u>Age 1-6 years</u>: 4 doses with one dose given on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday OR any 5 doses. <u>Ages 7 years or older</u>: 3 doses.

**Tdap** – For students born after 1/1/1997 and entering or attending Grade 6 or above –1 dose given no earlier Than 10 years of age.

A child is not required to have a Tdap dose until FIVE years after the last DTaP.

**POLIO** –<u>Ages 1-6 years</u>: 3 doses, with one dose given on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday, OR any 4 doses. <u>Ages 7 years or older</u>: 3 doses.

**MEASLES** – <u>If born before 1/1/90:</u> 1 dose of live measles-containing vaccine on or after the first birthday.

<u>If born on or after 1/1/90</u>: 2 doses of live measles-containing vaccine or one dose and lab evidence of immunity, preferably MMR (must be after  $1^{st}$  birthday and the two doses separated by at least one month)

**MUMPS** – 1 dose of live mumps-containing vaccine on or after the first birthday.

**RUBELLA** – 1 dose of live rubella-containing vaccine on or after the first birthday.

VARICELLA (Chicken Pox) – one dose after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday for students born on or after 1/1/98. Laboratory evidence of immunity, parent or MD statement of previous varicella disease is acceptable.

## HEPATITIS B

K-Grade 12: 3 doses

<u>Ages 11-15 years:</u> 2 doses of Hepatitis B Adolescent formulation **if not previously vaccinated with the 3 dose series.** 

**MENINGOCOCCAL**–<u>If born after 1/1/97</u>:and entering or attending <u>Grade 6 or above</u> – <u>1 dose against the four serogroups ACWY present in the vaccines licensed for use in the U.S.( Menactra or Menveo)</u>

Required when students turn 11 years of age; given no earlier than age 10.

**MANTOUX** –( tuberculin skin test) for students coming from certain countries (The fourpronged Tine Test is *not* acceptable.)

- 2. Copy of birth certificate with official seal (not a hospital certificate)
- 3. Physical exam signed by M.D. completed 365 days or less prior to admission
- 4. Health History form (filled out by parents)
- 5. Dental visit 6 months or less prior to admission

## Records of the above requirements MUST BE COMPLETED AND APPROVED by the school nurse <u>no later than August 30<sup>th</sup></u>

NO STUDENT WILL BE PERMITTED TO ATTEND THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL WITHOUT SUBMITTING ITEMS 1-4.

These must be on file in the nurse's office in order to meet NJ State requirements.
