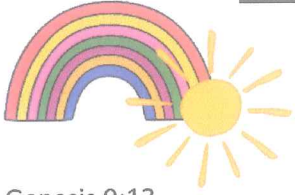

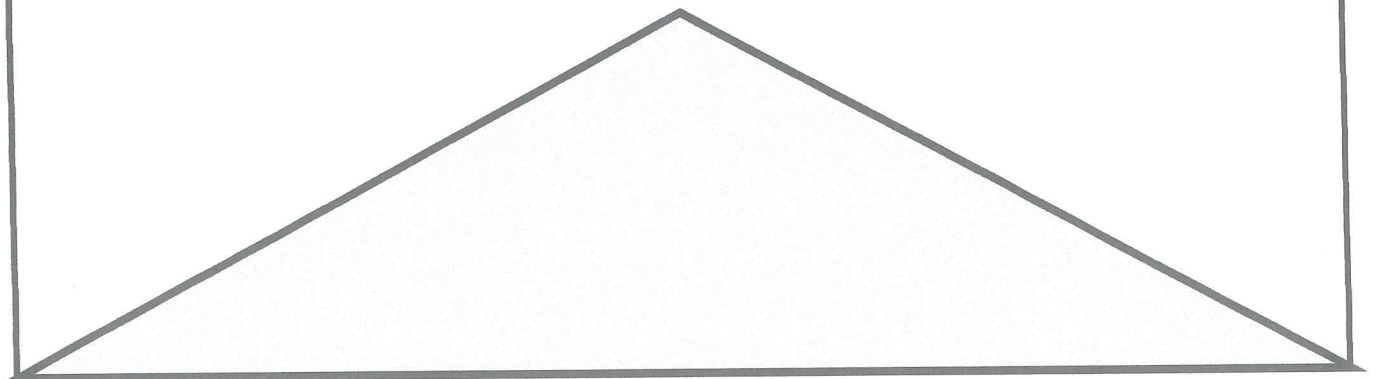

Reading Discussion Questions

Before, during, and after reading either independently or together, ask your child a few of these questions to spark conversations and build reading comprehension.

Before Reading

- What do you think will happen in this story? How do you know?
- What's the title? What does it tell us?
- Where do you think this story will take place? or What's the setting of the story?
- Let's go on a picture walk – what do you notice in the pictures?
- What do you think this book will be about? What do you think we'll learn?
- What do you already know about this topic?
- What are you wondering?
- What questions do you have?

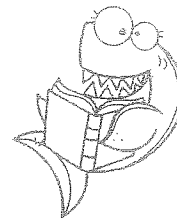
During Reading

- What do you think will happen next? What questions do you have?
- Who are the characters we've met so far? What are you thinking about the characters?
- What's the setting? Where is the story taking place?
- What does this story remind you of?
- What have we learned so far?
- Hmm....I'm wondering... What are you wondering?
- Is this all making sense? Are there any parts we need to reread?
- Why do you think _____ did or said that? How do you think he/she feels?

After Reading

- Did you like the ending? Why/why not?
- What was the problem in the story? What was the solution?
- Why do you think the author wrote this book? What did he/she want us to learn?
- What new words did you learn?
- What was your favorite part? What was your least favorite part?
- What questions do you still have? What are you still wondering?
- What do you think was the most important part?
- Would you recommend this book to a friend? Why/why not?
