<b>Position Title:</b>	Physical Education Teacher

<b>Position Responsibilities:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Develops and administers Physical Education classes consistent with school goals and objectives.</li> <li>• Teaches knowledge of, and develops skills and abilities in, physical fitness, coordination and agility, exercise, and sports,</li> <li>• Develops students' concepts in leadership, teamwork, responsibility and social skills; providing a safe and optimal learning environment; and appropriate feedback regarding student progress, expectations, and goals.</li> <li>• Conducts ongoing assessment of student growth and progress in physical educational activities, and modifies instructional methods to fit individual student's needs, including students with special needs.</li> <li>• Continues to acquire professional knowledge and learn of current developments in the educational field by attending seminars, workshops or professional meetings, or by conducting research.</li> <li>• Organizes and maintains a system for accurate and complete record-keeping, grading, and reporting for all student activities, achievement and attendance as required by school procedures and applicable laws.</li> <li>• Encourages parental involvement in students' education and ensures effective communication with students and parents.</li> <li>• Ensures that student conduct conforms to the school's standards and school policies and establishes and maintains standards of student behavior needed to achieve a functional learning atmosphere in the classroom.</li> <li>• Coordinates with other professional staff members, especially within physical education and grade level, and participates in faculty meetings and committees.</li> <li>• Selects and requisitions appropriate instructional aids and other supplies and equipment and maintains inventory records.</li> <li>• Inspects equipment and field areas used to ensure they are in good and safe working order.</li> </ul>
<b>Position Qualifications:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bachelor's degree in education discipline applicable to teaching assignment and able to achieve A.C.S.I certification in his/her related teaching area.</li> <li>• The teacher must have received Jesus Christ as his/her Savior and believe that the Bible is God's Word and standard for daily living.</li> <li>• The teacher shall support the doctrinal position of TCS and will abide by the Standard of Conduct.</li> <li>• The teacher shall be in fellowship with a local church that has a doctrinal position consistent with that of TCS and support its ministry through regular attendance and participation.</li> <li>• The teacher shall see teaching as a "calling" from God and agree with the school's philosophy of education and instruction.</li> </ul>
