VISION

Established in 2005, the goal of Timothy's International Program (TIP) is to provide international students in grades 6-12 with a rigorous academic education while developing Christian character in the context of the American culture.

ELL SUPPORT

TCS provides a strong ESL/ELL program in order to improve each student's level of English, enabling him or her to succeed in all academic subjects.

Multi-level courses are taught to middle and high school students in grammar, reading, listening comprehension, writing and vocabulary. Students are placed in ELL courses using the TOEFL and TOEFL Jr. tests. In addition, classes help students learn about their new school culture.

Academics

Honor and college level AP courses, electives, debate, robotics, drama, arts, music and athletics are offered. Students are challenged to reach their highest potential and be prepared to attend a four year college or university.



Character

Honesty, integrity, responsibility, respect, discipline, kindness, strong work ethic, and loving others are taught and modeled by our faculty for our students.



Community

TIP students are included in all areas of the TCS community. They will become part of a supportive family environment away from home. Caring host homes ensure that students are provided for physically, mentally, and emotionally.



ACADEMICS

TCS offers a rigorous academic program where students are given the opportunity to develop their critical thinking, collaboration, creativity and problem solving skills under the guidance of highly trained teachers who average 17 years of teaching experience in their fields. AP courses in calculus, statistics, chemistry, biology, computer, science, English and US history and Honors courses in physics, human anatomy and Spanish are offered.

The facilities at TCS, which include three science labs, two computer labs, a media center, robotics classroom, art room, yearbook lab, music and drama rooms, gymnasium, weight room and athletic fields, provide ample space for students to explore, investigate, research, showcase and expand their interests and talents.

In order to be considered for high school at TCS, international students must score a minimum of a 60 on the TOEFL exam and continue to meet progressively higher TOEFL benchmark scores in order to remain in the program.

One hundred percent of our international students go on to attend a four year college or university.
